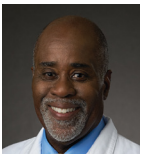

BREAST CANCER SURGERY AND RECONSTRUCTION

- Breast conservation surgery with oncoplastic reconstruction
- Minimally-invasive hidden scar technique
- Nipple-and areola-sparing mastectomy
- Skin-sparing mastectomy
- Sentinel lymph node biopsy and axillary lymph node dissection
- Downstaging of the axilla with neoadjuvant chemotherapy
- Coordination with radiation oncologist for IORT/APBI
- Surgical prophylactic mastectomy for high-risk patients
- Surgical management of high-risk lesions and benign breast disease

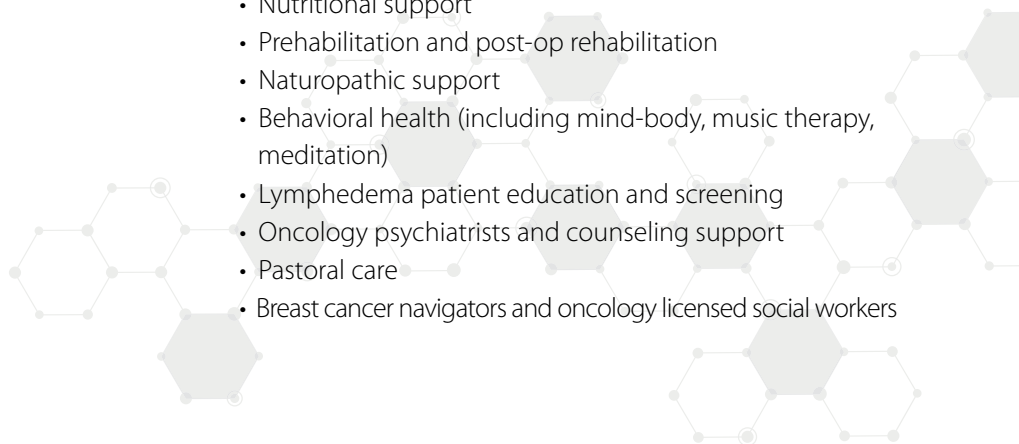
